STATE RELAY RESULTS SPECIAL

It was a weekend of hot competition and even hotter weather over the two days of the State Relay Championships. Our athletes did the Club proud with stunning performances and incredible efforts from the entire squad across the weekend.

In total **1283 teams** from across NSW battled it out in running, throwing and jumping relays – with 667 teams competing on the Junior Day (U8-U11) and 616 teams on the Senior Day (U12-U17). This included **30 Junior and 15 Senior teams from Balmain**, our largest ever contingent at State Relays.

See page 2 for full results and column right for a summary, but I am delighted to report that we came away with a total of **12 medals in our bag** – including our **first State Relay Record** in as long as anyone can remember set by the U13 girls 4x100m squad. In total **38 of our 45 teams finished in the top10** in their event.

With so many fantastic performances across the board it's hard to single anyone out for special attention, but I would like to congratulate the U8G who had to rerun their final of the 4x100m and were able to hold on to the Bronze medal they had thought they had secured earlier. Also a hearty congratulations to our senior group who took home 4 gold medals on Day 2. The best result ever by this cohort of athletes. Well Done.

The LANSW officials complimented Balmain on the way the Club performed its duties, so many thanks to all the parents who helped with the running of events and to Tim Batho who officiated at the long jump for 6 hours in 38' heat.

Special thanks to **Richard Chen and Peter Rand** who did superb jobs managing the junior teams. Also thanks to the parents who assisted in **the coaching** of our baton changing, throwing and jumping, your efforts really paid off.

The Balmain club did itself proud this weekend. Our athletes were happy and humble receiving medals, they were the first to congratulate their opponents at the finish and as a team we were the most supportive club in the grand-stand.

We're looking forward to seeing what we can now achieve at the Zone Championships on 13/14th December.


