262 proud and eager BLAC athletes entered the Inner City Zone Championships across 967 events. ES Marks Stadium was drenched in a sea of Black & Gold as BLAC spirit was on show for all to see.....and hear. Balmain athletes, from novice u7s to experienced u17s, received the same deafening roar from the sidelines as they ran, jumped and threw themselves into competing against the six other clubs of the Inner City Zone.

We went into the Zone Champs as the reigning Club Champion after last year's first ever win. As recently as 2010 Balmain placed 5th with 687 points, while in 2015 we won with 2,838. This year's team exceeded all expectations, accumulating 4,127 points to defend our Zone title with a margin of 1297 points! This demonstrates just how far we have come in the last few years. It is also a great testament to the spirit of our athlete body by competing in as many events as possible to maximise our club point score. Well done to each and every one

As to our athletes' results for the weekend. Wow! We couldn't keep count of the athletes who wanted to tell us how they went. And not "I won" or "I came fourth" it was usually "I did a 10sec PB" or "I did a 4m PB throw". Tremendous to hear and special to watch their joy in doing the best they could. 


